
11th ARVES Jenever Tourney 2018

1.f4

For White it is more important to save the e-pawn instead of the f-pawn. 1. 空d2? 必xe5-+

1...∲g3

Active play to attack f4. 1...a5 2. dd2=

2.∲e2!

It is curious that the White king has to protect the kingside, but not the queenside. Black's pawn on a7 will be stopped by the white knight which even twice moves to the opposite side corner to reach on time.

2.... 2xf4+ 3. 2xf4 dxf4 4. 2g6+!

Now the role of the e-pawn is obvious because the knight cannot be taken. 4.26f3? a5-+

4...∲e4!
