# 9th ARVES Jenever Tourney 2016

During the 59th WFCC-Congress in Belgrade (Serbia) in August 2016 ARVES organised its 9th Jenever Tourney for studies. The proposed theme was a smothered mate with a promoted knight. Although several composers feared that it would be difficult to improve on already existing schemes, I still received 21 entries:

Siegfried Hornecker (1), Daniel Keith (2), Wieland Bruch & Martin Minski (3), Jan Timman (4), Vladislav Tarasiuk (5-6), Pavel Arestov (6-7), Vladimir Samilo (8), Geir Sune Østmoe (9), Oleg Pervakov (10 and 19), Evgeny Kopylov (11), David Gurgenidze & Martin Minski (12), Branislav Djurasević (13), Darko Hlebec (14-15), Mirko Miljanić (16), Emauel Manolas (17-18), Oleg Pervakov & Evgeny Kopylov (20-21).


Of those, one was incorrect, and several others non-thematic. For the award, I selected six.

Is the prizewinner thematic? There has been discussion whether *all* the squares around bK had to be occupied by black pieces. Not all encyclopedias require this in their definition of smothered mate. I have decided not to be too strict. After all, what is the point of putting a black piece on a square that is already covered by wS?

However, I did not accept cooperation to the mate by other white pieces.

Who would expect a smothered mate from the starting position? After lively play and clever defensive manoeuvres, the mate is achieved by several selfblocks. The composer could not avoid that Black moves first, but this is only a small blemish.




This is exactly what I was looking for. A thematic model mate, and all pieces reach their position during the play. Unfortunately there is little black counterplay.






